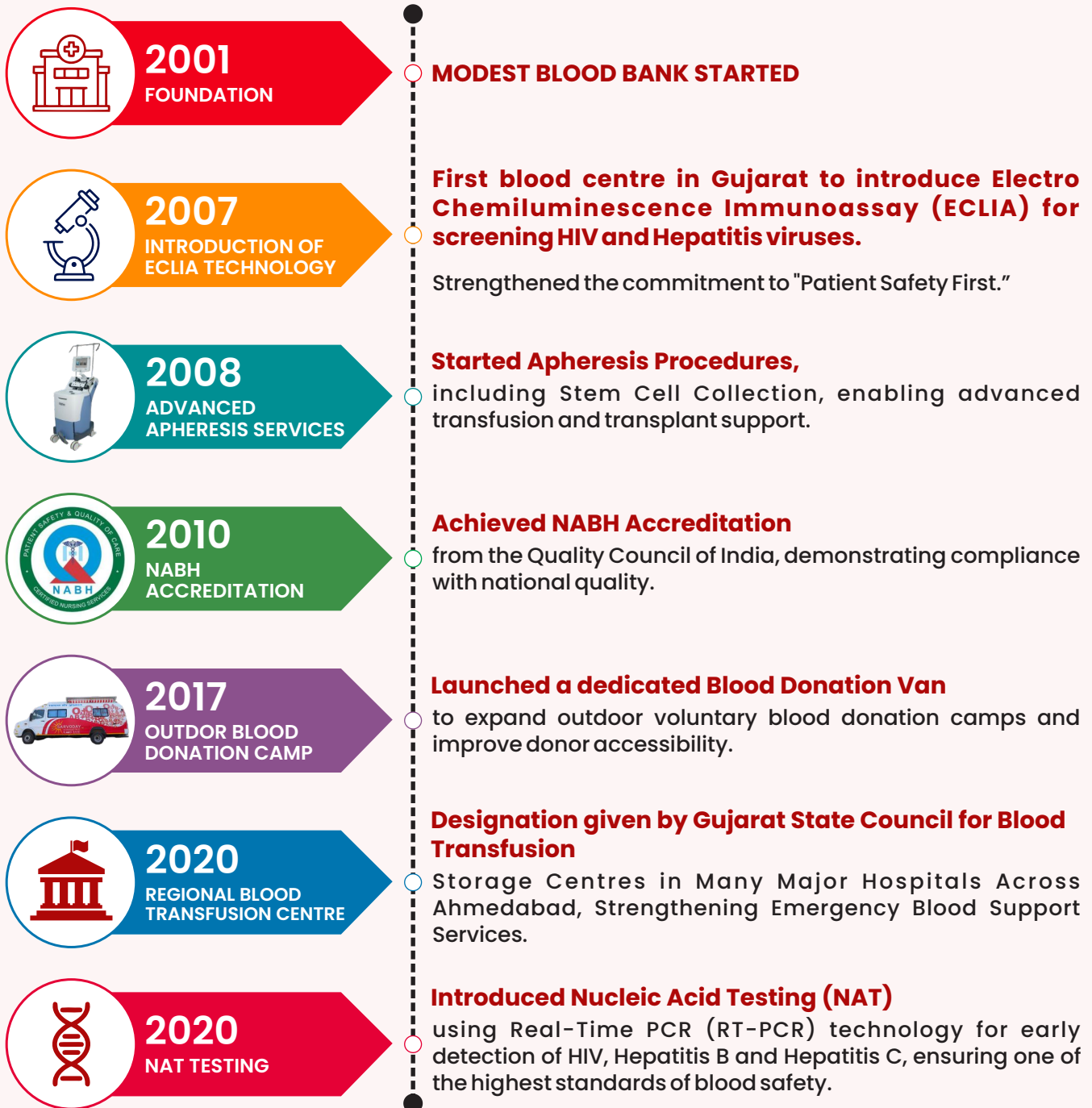

Who Can Donate? And Before & After Donation



Age **18 to 65 years**



Weight **Minimum 45 kg**



Hemoglobin **Minimum 12.5 g/dl**



Health **Must be in good health and not suffering from any major illness**



Interval Between two Donations **3 months (90 days) for men & 4 months (120 days) for women.**

A short medical check-up will be done before donation by the medical officer



DO'S



Do check that 3 months have passed since your last blood donation.



Do take light food/breakfast before blood donation.



Do fill up the donor form correctly.



Do check that lancets/needles used for screening are disposable.



Do take a glass of water before blood donation.



Do inform the technician/doctor, if at all you feel any discomfort during or after blood donation.



Do lie down with legs elevated, if you feel giddiness after blood donation.



Do take plenty of liquid (juice/tea/coffee/drinking water) for next 2-3 hrs after blood donation.

DON'TS



Do not donate on an empty stomach.



Do not remove bandages for next one hour at least.



Do not exercise for a while after blood donation.



Do not hide any medical or personnel history.



Do not consume tobacco in any form before & after one hour of blood donation.



Do not donate blood immediately after heavy meal.

Did You Know?

One Blood Donation Can Help Save Up to Three Lives

A single unit of donated blood is separated into different blood components, allowing one donation to benefit multiple patients with different medical needs.



PACKED RED BLOOD CELLS (PRBCs):

Used for patients with severe anemia, major blood loss, trauma, surgery, cancer, and thalassemia.



PLATELETS:

Used for patients with dengue, leukemia, cancer patients receiving chemotherapy, aplastic anemia, and other conditions causing low platelet counts.



FRESH FROZEN PLASMA (FFP):

Used for patients with liver disease, severe bleeding, major burns, clotting factor deficiencies, massive transfusion, Patients on blood thinners undergoing surgery.



CRYOPRECIPITATE (Prepared from FRESH FROZEN PLASMA):

Used to treat Hemophilia A (when specific factor concentrates are unavailable), hypofibrinogenemia, afibrinogenemia, and other fibrinogen deficiency disorders, like DIC.

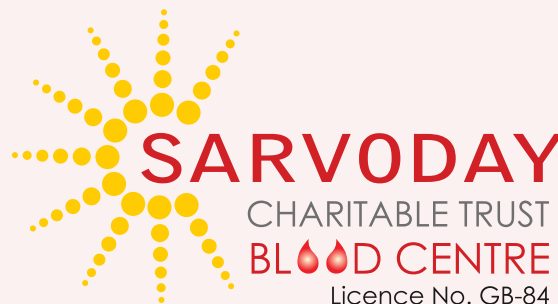
